2023 National Building Safety Month Coloring Contest

In honor of National Building Safety Month brought to you by the International Code Council (ICC), the City of St. Cloud's Building Department is holding a Coloring Contest based on the theme, **Safety for All: Building Codes in Action**. This year's theme encourages us all to raise awareness about planning for safe and sustainable construction; career opportunities in building safety; understanding disaster mitigation, energy conservation; and creating a safe and abundant water supply to all of our benefit. With this theme in mind, the following coloring contest will be held involving local students from elementary schools within City limits.

**OFFICIAL RULES**

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS CONTEST.

- 1) **HOW TO ENTER:** Please mail, or drop off your artwork, submission form and waiver by 4 pm on **May 31, 2023** to: *City of St Cloud, Building Department, 1300 Ninth Street, Bldg A, 1st Floor, St. Cloud, Florida 34769*. You may also submit online by uploading your submission at (<https://www.stcloudfl.gov/FormCenter/Building-Permit-Applications-3/Coloring-Contest-Submission-148>) The submission form and waiver must be complete with all applicable information. Back of artwork should include the student's name and grade. **No artwork will be accepted after the deadline.**
- 2) **ELIGIBILITY:** Any student (charter, private, home, or traditional school) in 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> grade may submit only one entry.
- 3) **GUIDELINES AND RESTRICTIONS:**
  - a. All applicants must fill out a submission form and waiver by the deadline in order to participate.
  - b. Artwork must be colored by the student.
  - c. Artwork must not disparage the City of St. Cloud, FL.
  - d. Artwork must not contain material that is inappropriate, indecent, obscene, tortuous, defamatory, slanderous or libelous, or that depicts any uncontrolled hazard or any unsafe procedure or practice.
  - e. Artwork must not contain material that promotes bigotry, racism, hatred or harm against any group or individual or to promote discrimination based on race, gender, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation or age.
  - f. The entry must not contain material that is unlawful, in violation of or contrary to the laws or regulations in any jurisdiction where the entry is created.
  - g. The entry may not include personal contact information such as but not limited to license number, name, address, phone number, social security number, passport number, driver's license number, date of birth or any other personal identification except as is specifically requested.
  - h. All artwork submitted are public records and may be made available for inspection or copying in accordance with Florida's Public Record Law.
- 4) **USE OF ARTWORK:** By submitting artwork, each entrant agrees that the City of St. Cloud, FL shall have the perpetual right to use, display or reproduce the artwork in any manner and in any media now existing or subsequently developed without further obligation to or permission by the entrant.
- 5) **DISCLAIMER:** The City of St. Cloud, FL is not responsible for (a) lost, late, misrouted, damaged or illegible entries, (b) any computer- or communications-related malfunctions or failures or disruptions or losses caused by events beyond the control of the City of St. Cloud, FL.
- 6) **JUDGING:** 1 winner will be selected from each grade from a panel of City of St. Cloud staff. The decision of the judges will be final in all matters relating to this competition. The prizewinners will be notified by email or phone call.
- 7) **ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**
  - a. The competition is void where restricted or prohibited by law.
  - b. Odds of winning are dependent upon the number of entries received.
  - c. By entering the art competition, all entrants agree to abide by and accept the Official Rules.
  - d. All entrants and winners agree to allow the City of St. Cloud, FL to use their names, location and related personal information and artwork for promotional purposes without obtaining further consent or providing compensation.

- e. By accepting a prize, the winners agree that the City of St. Cloud, FL will not have any liability for any injuries, losses or damages of any kind incurred in connection with or resulting from the use or misuse of any prize, or while traveling to, preparing for and/or participating in any prize-related activity.
- 8) **PRIZES:** The prizes for the City of St. Cloud Coloring Contest 2023 are as follows:
- a. 1<sup>st</sup> Grade First Place: Tablet
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade First Place: Tablet
  - c. Winners and results will be announced no later than June 16<sup>th</sup> 2023 and posted on the Building Departments webpage.
